



“So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.”

How is true discipleship built or developed?

“Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.

But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.”

How is true discipleship built or developed?

What A Disciple Does

- **Obeys** Jesus (Luke 6:46)
- Spends **regular time** with Jesus in scripture, prayer, meditation
- **Studies** the scripture
- Lives in a **community** of believers – fellowship
- **Shares** the gospel with friends

What a disciple is

Grows in character (dealing with anger, integrity, love, etc.)

Concern for the lost neighbors


The Core Issues

THE IMPERATIVE OF DISCIPLEMAKING

Discipling is a Process

- Of helping a person GROW
- According to a PLAN
- Which reflects the person's NEED
- Over a flexible, but definite period of TIME
- Which focuses on a GOAL
- Of becoming a LABORER
- In that person's CONTEXT of life and ministry
