## ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Mike Treneer was born and grew up in the rural SouthWest of England. He came to faith in Christ through the Navigator ministry at the University of Loughborough. After graduating, Mike worked as a Chemical Engineer and then married Chris in 1971. Together they joined the staff of the British Navigators to lead a ministry at the University of Southampton. Later, while leading the ministry in London, Mike made exploratory visits to Nigeria and went on to lead the team that pioneered the Navigator work in Nigeria. In 1981 Mike was appointed Africa Director. For 16 years Mike and Chris lived in Nairobi, Kenya, and traveled and ministered extensively in many African countries. In June 1998 Mike was appointed an International Vice President. They moved to Colorado Springs from where Mike gave oversight to the Navigator ministries in Europe, Russia, Australia and New Zealand. In January 2005 Mike became the 4th International President of the worldwide Navigator work, which Mike led for 10 years until April 2015.

Mike and Chris now divide their time between England and Colorado. They continue to be passionate about teaching the Scriptures, coaching emerging leaders, investing in others couple to couple — and in their family of three married children and eight grandchildren!
