Establishing/Equipping

As we invest in others, we do need to be mindful of where they are in their spiritual journey. Are they just curious about spiritual things? Are they going through a difficult time and searching for answers? Did they grow up in a Christian home? Did they experience rejection in their home of origin?

In each case, we must prayerfully come to understand where the Holy Spirit is working in each person's life. How do we do this on a practical basis?

- 1. Ask questions! Be genuinely curious.
- Listen. Don't do all the talking. Let them share as much as they wish to share.
- 3. Reflect back to them what you are hearing to make sure you understand.
- 4. Point them to God's Word for answers.
