***Reflections on Discipleship  
from the Sermon on the Mount  
Matthew 5-7***

The teaching of Jesus in Matthew 5-7 has been called by one of David Wooddell's mentors "The First Christian Retreat." As Jesus called his disciples to himself, he began to teach them the character and influence needed to be his disciples as they engaged contemporary culture. Jesus' message to his disciples is to be different! Different in character, influence, righteousness, relationships, spiritual disciplines, priorities, and choices. When you learn these Kingdom values you will have a positive influence as a disciple of Christ in a contemporary culture.

John Stott says the Sermon on the Mount is the most complete delineation anywhere in the New Testament of the Christian counterculture.

This weekend listen carefully to the words of Jesus as if you were on the mountain top with him, and he was speaking personally to you. Examine what Jesus told his disciples about being a disciple and what it would look like for you as His disciple, in your family, your work, and your life, if you fully obeyed the principles of this teaching.
