Since the mission to be and make disciples is Christ’s idea, the most important question is, “What does He think it means?” Jesus not only gave us a mission but a model. We can’t change the mission or improve on the model. Our challenge is to understand what discipleship looks like on the resurrection side of the cross. - Message #3 – The Motivation of Discipleship: The Iridescent Love of God

Disciplemaking was the strategy of the church that swept through the Roman Empire in the first three centuries. Without political clout, educational degrees, financial resources, or majority control these early followers of Christ impacted an empire. It could happen again.
