PROFILES OF A DISCIPLE

A Basic Disciple is a follower of Jesus Christ who:

1. Puts Christ first in the major areas of life and is taking steps to separate from sin.

2. Continues in the Word through study, memorization and application of the Word to his life.

3. Has a consistent daily devotional time and is developing his prayer life.

Ephesians 6:18 John 15:5-7

4. Demonstrates Christ's love by identifying with and serving other believers.

John 13:34,35 Galatians 5:13

5. Is identifying with Jesus Christ in his environment and is actively sharing his faith.

Matthew 5:16 Colossians 4:6

- 6. Has been growing in these five areas for at least *18 months.

A Ministering Disciple:

- 1. Is continuing as a Basic Disciple.
- 2. Is accountable to a leader or discipling team for development in his life and ministry.
- 3. Is presenting the Gospel regularly with increasing skill.
- 4. Is growing in understanding of disciplemaking and <u>participating</u> in <u>discipling</u> others (may be leading a Bible study group with an evangelistic or growth intent).

A Disciplemaker is a Laborer who:

- 1. Is growing as a Basic Disciple.
- 2. Has personally led at least one other to Christ.
- 3. Has been the major influence in raising up one new Basic Disciple.
- 4. Is currently engaged in and continuing to grow in his understanding of evangelism and discipling.

A Disciplemaking Leader:

- 1. Is a Disciplemaker, and an *Equipper.
- 2. Has drawn together a disciplemaking team; i.e., two or more Christians who are working together to evangelize and establish others.
- 3. Is leading the team, providing cohesion and direction.
